

School Uniform: Proud to be at Winston

Blazer	Black blazer with school badge stitched to the left breast pocket.	Fitted, torn or frayed blazer
Shirt	A traditional white collared shirt with either long or short sleeves. Top button fastened and shirt tucked in.	Any colour other than white. Blouses, collarless, or tailored shirts.
Key Stage 3 Tie	The Winston School tie (black with red stripes), tied correctly showing 6 red stripes.	Any other tie. School ties that have been coloured or threads removed. Ties shorter than 6 red stripes
Key stage 4 Ties	Plain black Winston upper school tie with school badge displayed. Prefect tie tied to the correct length.	Ties without the school badge or without the badge on display.
Skirt	Compulsory black knee length skirt with distinctive waistband trim. Purchased solely from G&S by Valentino limited Tel: 01483 473357.	Any colour other than black. Skirts with slits, rolled up, overly tight or made of a knitted/stretch material.
Trousers	Plain black, straight-leg trousers with a waistband and centre front zip. Worn at the waist.	Any colour other than black. Hipsters, turn-ups, splits, flares, embroidery, jeans, combat styles, jean-style pockets. Stretch/knitted material, too tight, too baggy, torn or frayed trousers.
Belts	Plain black belt must be worn with trousers.	Fashion belts, coloured belts. No large decorative buckles.
Socks and tights	Socks: plain black, grey or white, below the knee. Tights: plain black or opaque.	Socks - any colour other than black, grey or white. Tights - any colour other than black or flesh. Any patterned tights. Bows and/or trimmings on socks.
Footwear	Plain black leather shoes, without embellishment. Trainers only for PE unless a medical note is provided.	Any trainer (including black trainers), ankle boots, stilettos, kitten heels, boots of any type, casual, canvas, plimsoles, platform soles or sling backs. Any branded sport shoe is considered a trainer.
Coats	A plain colour suitable for school.	Hooded sweatshirt, tracksuit material. jogging top type garments, denim, leather, corduroy jackets are not allowed to be worn on the premises. Offensive logos. Studded garments.
Hats	None, unless medical note provided.	All types of hat.
Hair	Hair must be one natural colour including braids. Hair extensions of cultural significance must be of a plain natural colour, matching the original hair colour. Smart, clean and tidy. Long hair must be tied back in practical lessons. Plain-coloured hair accessories. No shorter than Grade 2 all over; skin fades where "blending" starts before the top of the ear.	Extreme hairstyles: overly spiked or sculptured hair. Shaved areas or razor lines, obvious steps or hard lines, tram lines, cat scratches, eyebrow slits/notches or high skin fades. No beads or fashion accessories. Hair must not obscure the face.
Makeup	Discreet foundation or concealer Clear nail varnish.	Eye makeup, lipstick/lip gloss, coloured nail varnish False or long nails. False eyelashes or extensions
Jewellery	A watch (not "smart"). One pair of plain silver or gold-coloured studs in the ear lobe.	Rings, bracelets, chains, piercings (nose, tongue, eyebrow etc), badges or brooches,. Flesh tubes or spacers, earrings with gems or glass.
Bags	Rucksack able to hold at least two A4 textbooks and folders, a water bottle, Yonder Pouch and a pencil case.	Handbags, fashion bags, tote bags, shoulder bags, plastic or paper carrier bags.
Yondr pouch	School issued Yondr mobile phone pouch.	Damaged, broken or not working pouch.

Jumpers are not part of the uniform, student can wear plain white base layer beneath their shirt.

The Headteacher is the final arbiter on the suitability of uniform and appearance. If in doubt ASK.
