Questions to consider:

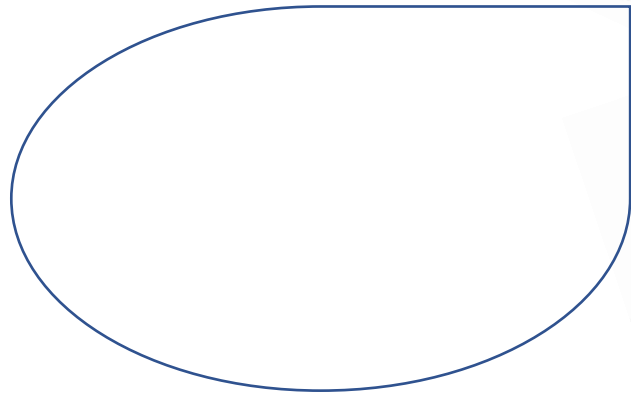
- What do you enjoy?

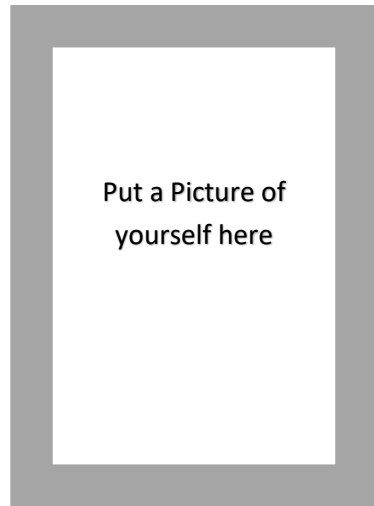

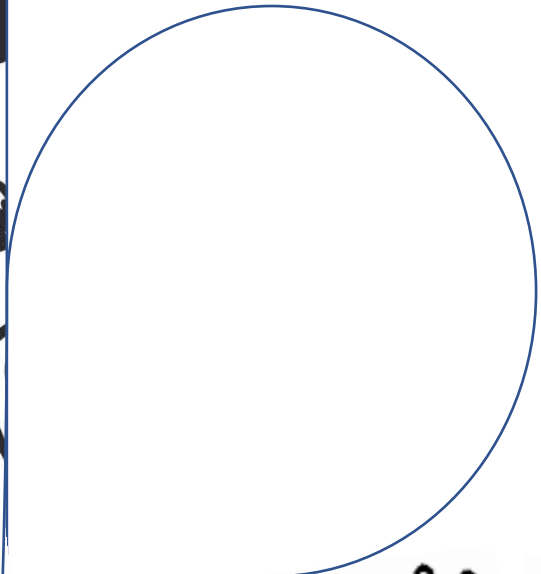
